
Gentlemen:




Gentlemen:







To the Honorable the City Council of Providence

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to report to your Honorable Body on the action taken by the police department as a result of a resolution requesting the Commissioner of Public Safety "to enforce the apparent violation of traffic regulations and that he request a change in delivery time at the junction of Nolan and Wayne Streets by truck drivers making deliveries at the Cumberland Milk Store, 393 Smith Street..."

There appears to be no violation of traffic ordinances in the use of a private lane for unloading. The driver previously unloaded on Smith St. and later on Nolan St., but the traffic congestion and the complaints of the neighbors caused the Cumberland Farms to use off-street loading.

Our investigators interviewed most of the signers of the petition, some of whom lived some distance from the scene (one from Rugby St. in South Providence). The originator of the petition, Michael Klanian, complained of the noise and alleged that his ceilings were cracked and light fixtures fell due to the movement of the truck. Most of the signers stated that noise was their complaint especially during the warm summer evenings when windows were open. The noise is not so apparent now.

On the spot checks by our investigators showed a current arrival of the truck about 7:30 P.M.. The driver stated that occasionally he arrives later when loading or other delays hold him up. He was most cooperative.

On this date, December 16, Commander George W. Wilding conferred with the management of the Cumberland Farms in Canton, Massachusetts, and they promised to arrange deliveries at about 5:30 P.M. from now on.

Throughout our whole investigation, the Cumberland Farms people were most cooperative.
