

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 441

Approved November 6, 1972

RESOLVED, That the Mount Pleasant Businessmen's Association is granted the privilege of erecting light decorations and related Christmas decorations for the 1972 Christmas Season along and over and across certain areas of Academy Avenue and Chalkstone Avenue as may be incorporated in the said Association's plans, all subject to the approval of the Director of Public Works and the Public Service Engineer; provided that the Mount Pleasant Businessmen's Association shall furnish to the City and file with the City Clerk a liability insurance policy certificate, approved as to form by the City Solicitor, its limits to be not less than One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, indemnifying the City against any claim arising out of any damage due to the erection, maintenance and/or removal of any decorations or parts thereof.
