

1.	Petition from Daniel Corley, Head of School, Community Preparatory School, Inc. 126 Somerset Street, Providence, Rhode Island 02903, requesting to abandon a portion of Somerset Street.	The Department of Public Works has reviewed this request and has no objection to this request.
2.	Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the implementation of a traffic study along Lenox Avenue between Broad Street and Niagara.	In order to properly address this resolution, the Traffic Engineer requests clarification as to the purpose of the study to properly implement a traffic study.
3.	Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Resident Parking Only" Designated Signs in front of 3 Collyer Street and 4 Collyer Street, inclusive of penalties for violations.	The Director, City Engineer, and Traffic Engineering Division Supervisor met with the Councilman on Collyer street on November 4, 2015. It was agreed that the better solution was to install "No Parking" signs on both sides of the road. Those signs have been installed.
4.	Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Firefighter Personnel Parking Only" Designated Signs across from 325 Washington Street.	The current signs indicate no parking along that road for the safety and access of the firefighting vehicles to the fire station. The Public Safety Complex has a dedicated parking garage on Dean Street. It is not recommended to install these non-standard signs along this section of road.
5.	Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "No Parking" signs located on Whittaker Street between Westminster St and West Fountain Street.	Traffic Engineering investigated and concurs with this recommendation. Work orders will be created and the work will be done as soon as time permits.
