Gentlemen:

I have this date promulgated the following proclamation in accordance with Section 6, Chapter 4 of the City Ordinances.

### DOG QUARANTINE

Whereas, a positive report of rabies has been received on a dog's head this date from the State Laboratory, I, Joseph Smith, M. D., Superintendent of Health of the City of Providence, hereby order that no dog be allowed to run at large in said City for a ninety (90) day period, ending February 15, 1966. All dogs shall be properly leashed or muzzled unless fully immunized against rabies. Certificates of proper immunization shall be filed with both the Health and Police Departments.

Any licensed and collared dog found, during this period ending February 15, 1966, unleashed or unmuzzled on any street, highway or public place within said City of Providence, shall be impounded forthwith by the Dog Officer of this city for a period of five (5) days.

The owner or keeper of such dog so impounded may after the five day period and upon payment of the sum of \$3.00 to the Dog Officer, and showing proof of ownership, claim and remove said dog.


