
RESOLVED (1) That the City Council urge the passage by
the General Assembly of that Act entitled:


AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9 OF CHAPTER 489 OF THE

which provides that the City of Providence be allowed to offset
any Worker's Compensation payments and/or any award for damages
against the City of Providence for personal injuries on account
of the death or disability of any member of the City's retirement
system against any benefit payable under the retirement system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED (2) That the City Solicitor is
directed and authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to
assist in the passage of said act, substantially as set forth
in the proposed bill attached.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 489 of the Public Laws
2 of 1923, entitled "An Act to provide for the retirement of the
3 employees of the City of Providence," as amended, is hereby
4 further amended by addition of the following paragraph:
5 Deduction of Amounts Received from Worker's Compensation
6 or as Damages. -- Any amounts paid or payable under the provisions
7 of any worker's compensation law, or as the result of any action
8 for damages for personal injuries against the City of Providence,
9 on account of death or disability of a member, shall be offset
10 against and payable in lieu of any benefits payable out of funds
11 provided by the city under the provisions of its Retirement Act
12 (i.e., Ch. 489 of the Public Laws of 1923, as amended) on account
13 of the death or disability of the member. If the value of the
14 total commuted benefits under any such worker's compensation law
15 or action is less than the present value on an actuarial basis

1 of the benefits otherwise payable under those provisions and
2 shall be payable under those provisions of that act.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
