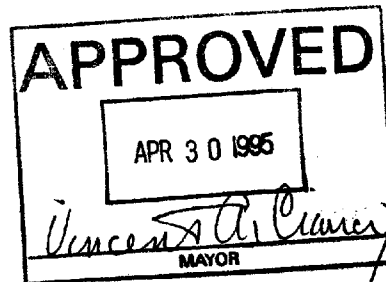

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. CHAPTER 5-24 OF THE GENERAL LAWS ENTITLED "TAVERNS,
2 COOKSHOPS, AND OYSTER HOUSES" IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDING THERETO
3 THE FOLLOWING SECTION:

4 5-24-4. Food extension license -- City of Providence --
5 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 5-24-1, the city of Providence may issue a "Food
6 Extension License" to a victualling house which is not the holder of an alcoholic beverage license.
7 A "Food Extension License" shall entitle the holder thereof to operate continuously after six
8 o'clock (6:00) a.m. but not after two o'clock (2:00) a.m. except for Fridays and Saturdays and the
9 night before Rhode Island holidays when the holder may remain open until three (3:00) a.m. The
10 annual fee for the license shall be two hundred dollars (\$200).

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would allow the city of Providence to issue a special Food Extension License.
- 2 The holder would be allowed to be open on Fridays, Saturdays and the day before Rhode
