

Gentlemen:

The intersection of Orms Street and Bath Street has been investigated to consider the advisability of intersection traffic signals as requested by City Council Resolution dated November 19, 1959.

An analysis of the traffic volumes and the accident experience of the past several years indicates that the existing stop control is adequately controlling traffic flow at the intersection. Therefore, traffic signal control is not recommended at this time.


