
Gentlemen:

Enclosed is a plan showing the construction of a channelization island on Crawford Street between South Main Street and South Water Street. This plan was originally sent to the Committee on Public Works on November 5, 1957, with the proposal to construct this island.

Since South Main Street and South Water Street have been made one way streets, the construction of this island permits a traffic connector from South Main Street to South Water Street, thereby eliminating the necessity for traffic to travel through Market Square in order to make a reversal of direction.

It is therefore requested that the appropriate resolution be approved to establish the southerly half of Crawford Street as a one way street in a westerly direction from South Main Street to South Water Street. The northerly half of Crawford Street will remain a one way street in an easterly direction as approved by a previous resolution.







the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the office of the Inspector of Buildings subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated, viz:

Ward 3: Pequot Realty, Inc., 929-931-935 North Main Street, Plat 5, Lots 156, 319, 320 and 321, five (5) gasoline filling pumps and 2-3,000, 1-2,000 and 1-4,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks, making a total of 12,000 gallons storage capacity and five (5) filling pumps upon the premises.

The erection or location of any buildings or structures not shown on the original plat on file with the Inspector of Buildings or any change in the location of buildings or structures from that shown on said plat shall be deemed a violation of this permit.


