

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 485

Approved August 16, 1999

WHEREAS, The West Broadway Neighborhood Association is applying to the State of Rhode Island for approval of their Transportation Enhancement (TEA-21) to do a Master Redevelopment Plan for West Broadway and the West End, and construction and implementation of infrastructure such as lighting, sidewalks and trees; and

WHEREAS, The Redevelopment Plan and the Infrastructure Improvements will be focused on the area from Broadway to Westminster Street and from the Route 95 Service Roads to Olneyville; and

WHEREAS, The proposed improvements would repair, revitalize and reconnect Westminster Street to Olneyville and Downtown Providence; and


WHEREAS, The project would finish sidewalks and trees along Westminster Street from Olneyville to the Route 95 Service Roads; and

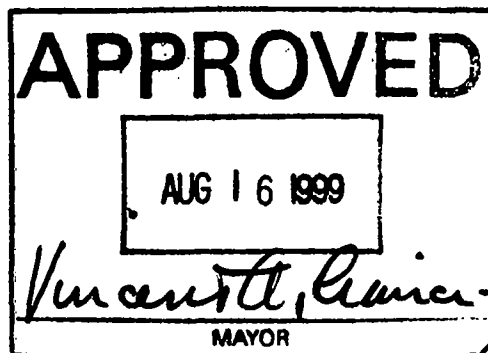
WHEREAS, The project would install decorative lighting along Westminster Street from Olneyville to Route 95 Service Roads; and

WHEREAS, The proposed Master Plan would integrate the Westminster Street improvements with other planned projects such as Three Cities, the planned Police/Fire Complex, Louttit, Armory and Cranston Street; and

WHEREAS, The proposal would leverage already allocated funding for Westminster Street lighting and infrastructure such as Community Development Block Grant and the Federal Transportation, Community and System Preservation Pilot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council supports the application of West Broadway Neighborhood Association to Rhode Island Department of Transportation as one of the City's top three projects.
