IT IS FURTHER

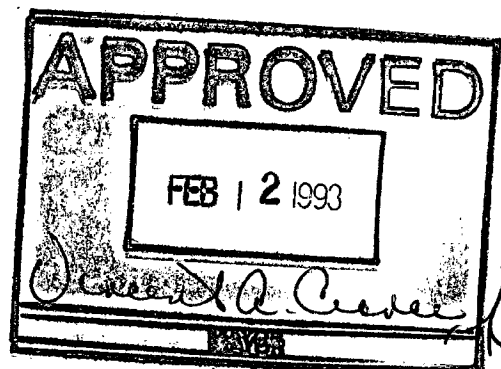

The proposed abandonment would result in eleven parcels of land becoming land-locked, possibly more, and PWSB would be unable to supply water to these parcels. Reference A.P. #126 Lots #210, #207, #206, #211, #205, #212, #203, #204, #213, #214, #215. Also there is currently a request for water service evaluation to this area from O. Ahlborg & Sons, Inc.; "Mashapaug Circle Project".

The City Planning Agency and/or City Council may want to consider the appropriate action to prevent land-locking of a lot; PWSB will not render service to any parcel not having direct access to public right of way.

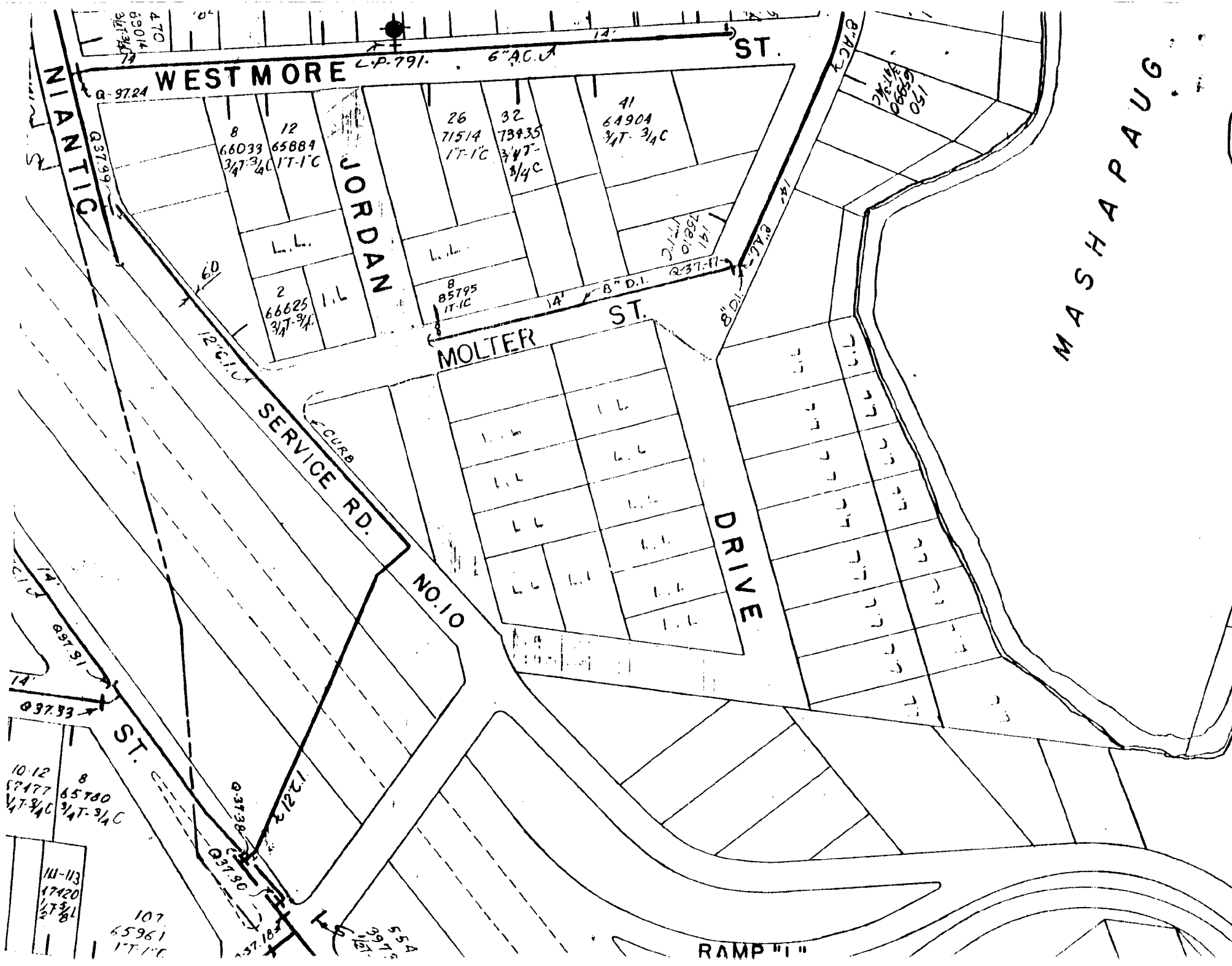
