RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause that missing street name sign "Miller Avenue" to be replaced at the corner of Broad Street.

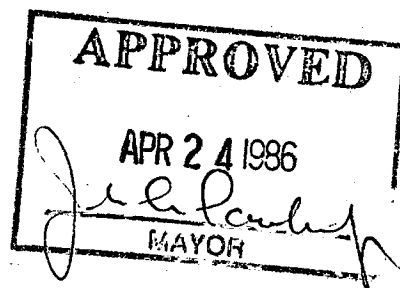

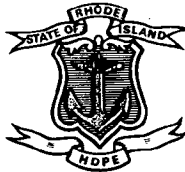
