Resolved, DECREEED AND ORDERED,

That Academy Avenue, from Burns Street, to

its southerly termination, as defined by the shaded area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept., Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 061709, Date April 25, 1958," has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Superintendent of Street Signs and Numbers be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on part of Academy Avenue, from Burns Street, to its southerly termination, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence, at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting upon part of Academy Avenue, from Burns Street, to its southerly termination, which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

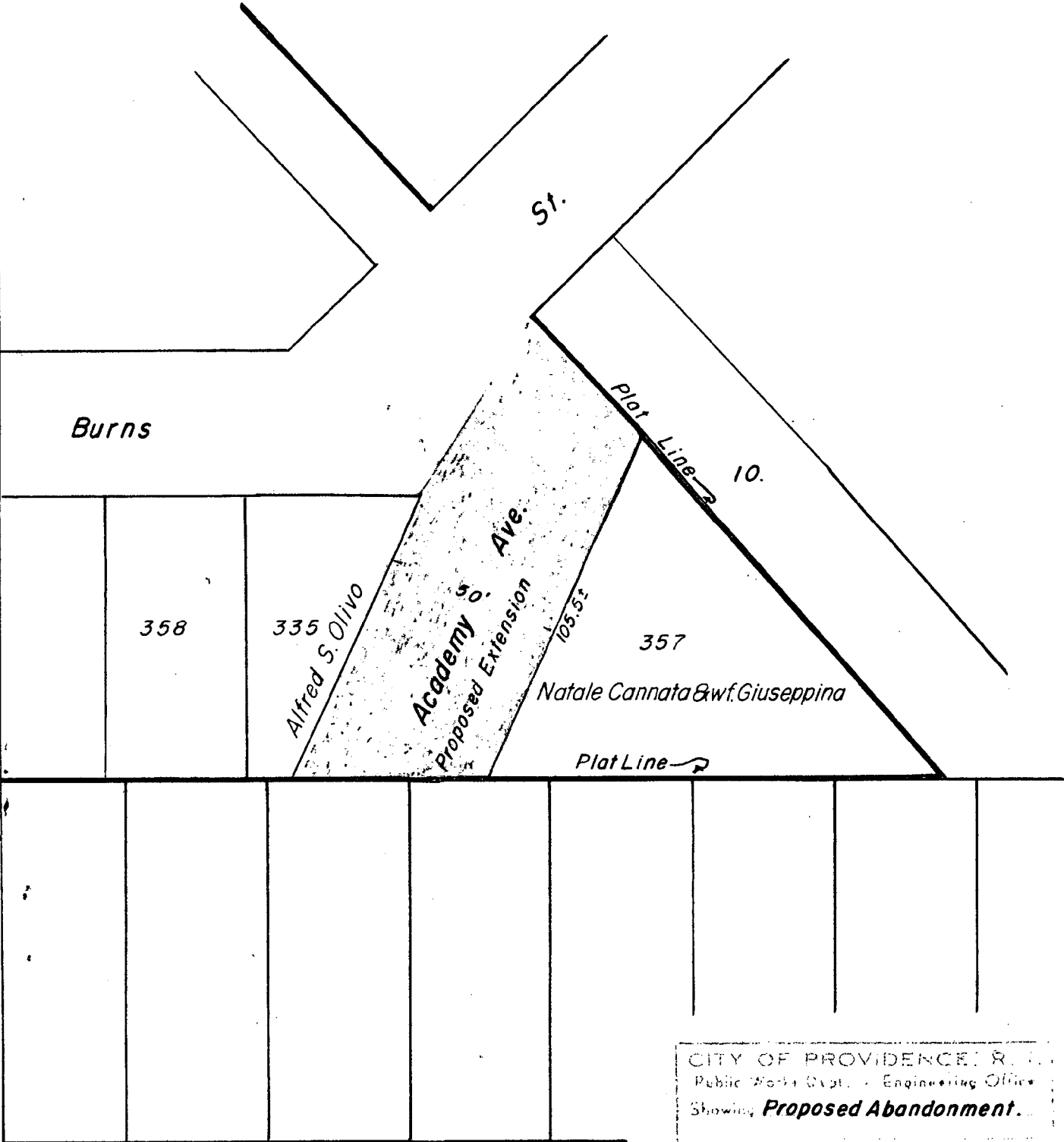
