AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER SIXTEEN OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS."

Approved August 7, 2008

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter Sixteen of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled "Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions", is hereby amended to add the following section:

Sec. 16-. Loitering on bus line property.

Any person who shall loiter or remain about in any bus terminal or platform, or at bus stops designated by Rhode Island Public Transit Authority (RIPTA), or on the grounds adjoining any bus stop terminal, after being requested to leave by any officer or agent of the company operating or using the facilities, shall be guilty of loitering and shall be fined not less than five nor more than one-hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
