RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 294

Approved April 26, 1984

WHEREAS, A vacancy exists in the Office of Mayor of the City of Providence, Rhode Island pursuant to Section 206 (a) (5) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, caused by the final conviction of a felony or a crime of moral turpitude and exhaustion of all appeals from said conviction on April 23, 1984, of Vincent A. Cianci, Jr., and

WHEREAS, The said vacancy did occur more than One Hundred Eighty Days before the time of the holding of the next succeeding regular City Election, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of Section 206 (b) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, it is mandatory that a Special Election for the purpose of filling such vacancy be held within ninety days of the date of the occurrence of such vacancy, and

WHEREAS, Section 17-15-4 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island provides a primary election for the nomination of such city or town officials shall be held and the local board shall fix the date thereof; provided, however, that said primary election shall have been held by the thirtieth (30th) day preceding the date fixed for said election,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, that, in compliance with the provisions of Section 206 (b) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, the said City Council does hereby order a Special Election to be held on July 17, 1984, for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Office of Mayor of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the final conviction of a felony on April 23, 1984 of Vincent A. Cianci, Jr., and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island; and that a duly certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the State of Rhode Island Board of Elections and to the Secretary of State or Rhode Island.




