That the following named highways shown as shaded areas on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works-Engineering Office, Street Line Section Map No. 063526, dated December 1, 1971,"

viz:

Alamo Lane, Try Street, Bowen Street and Cady Street, from the easterly line of Canal Street to the westerly line of North Main Street, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same are abandoned as public highways and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highways abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highways which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.







Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works request the abandonment of: Almo Lane, Try St., Bowen St., Cady St., Church St., Lamb St., a gangway, Otis St. and two gangways, Crockett St., No. Court St., and Haymarket St. those portions which run from Canal St. to North Main St. on Assessor's Plat 10.

The petition by the Providence Redevelopment Agency would use the land thus consolidated between Smith St. and Lonsdale St. for the Roger Williams National Memorial Park which will be constructed and operated by the U.S. Park Service, Department of the Interior. Plans have been made for the widening of both Lonsdale St. and that portion of Smith St. which runs between North Main St. and Canal St. to facilitate traffic flow in the area.


On a photographic and inspection survey it was determined that all the streets in question are narrow, seldom used alleys in condition varying from impassable to passable with caution in one direction only.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1825 - ABANDONMENT OF SEVERAL STREETS IN
SOUTH MAIN-SOUTH WATER STREETS AREA

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency, in order to carry out its plans for the rehabilitation of the South Water-South Main Section of the East Side Renewal Project, has petitioned for the abandonment of several small streets (see attached map) as follows:

1. Running from South Water Street to South Main Street; Bullion Street, Power Street, Gold Street, Silver Street, Guilden Street.
2. Running from South Main Street to Well Street; Harding's Alley and Pioneer Lane.
3. Well Street from Williams Street to Power Street and from Power Street to Planet Street.

Inspection revealed that the streets mentioned are narrow alleys, some unpaved and some blocked and unusable.

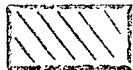

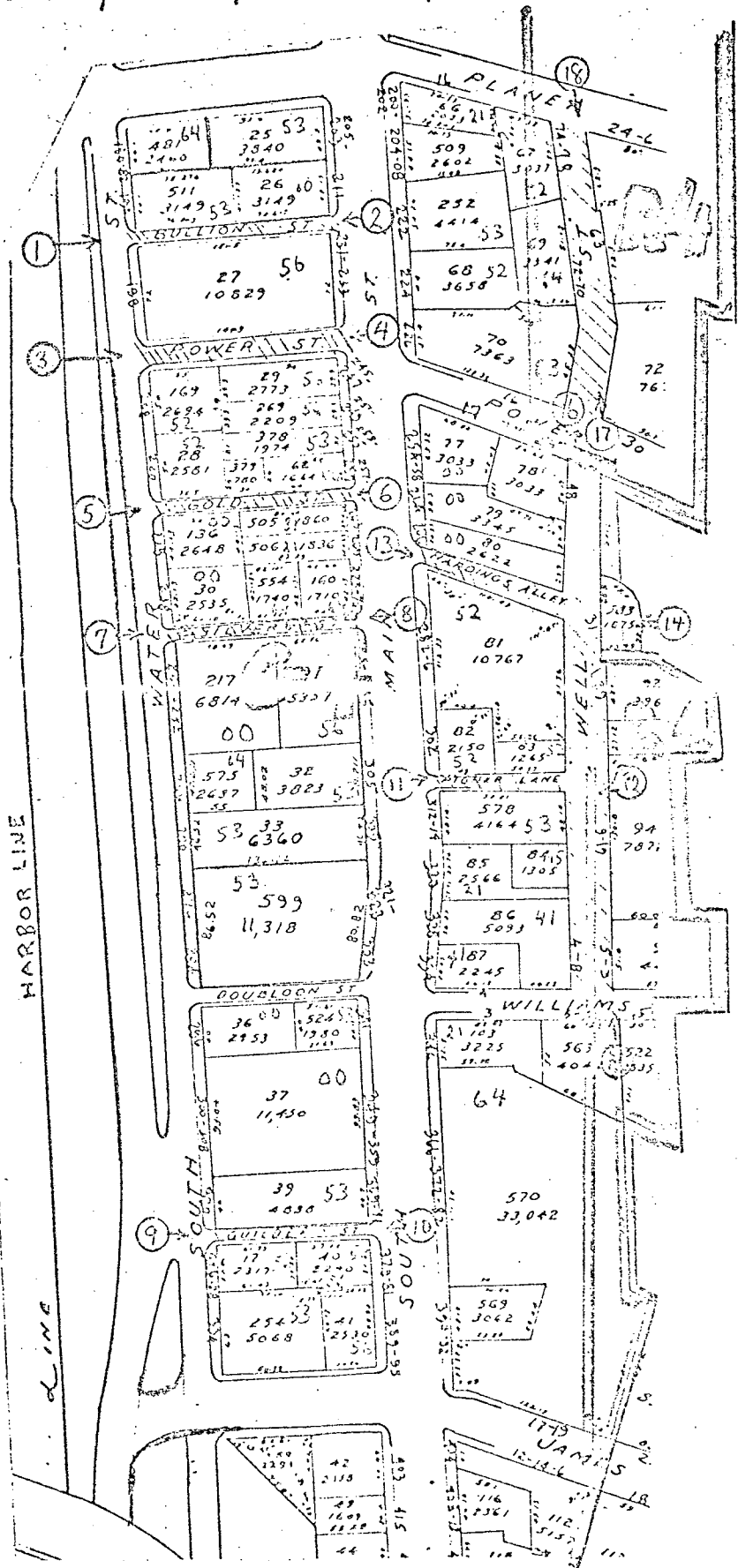

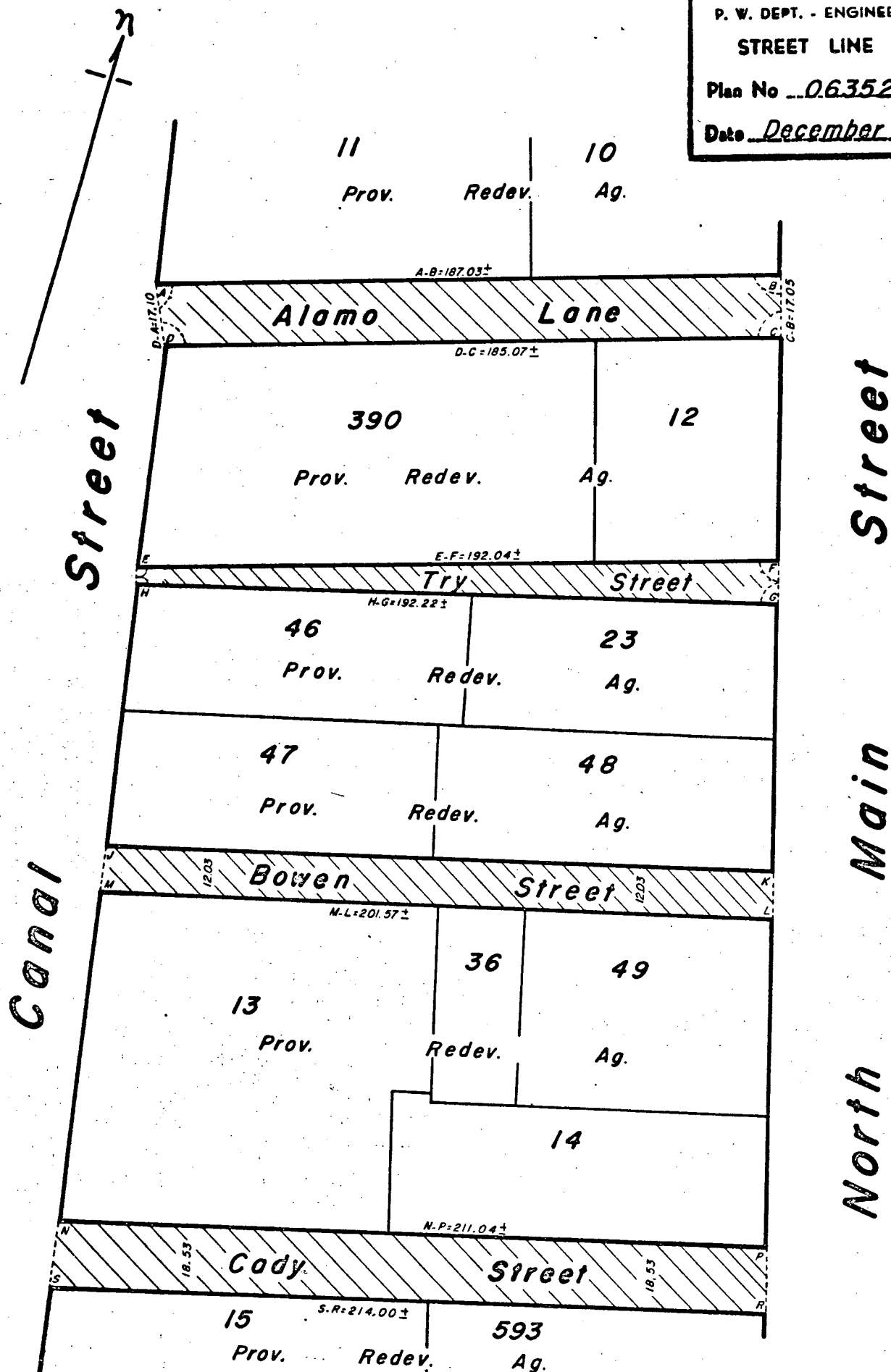
