RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 599

Approved September 13, 1993

RESOLVED, DECREED and ORDERED:

That Resolution #399 approved June 9, 1993 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled: "Providence, RI Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064543 dated April 7, 1993 and Plan No. 064544 dated April 12, 1993.

VIZ:

PINE STREET, (portions of), shown as cross-hatched area on accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway. Said Abandonment is specifically conditioned precedent upon the following: (1) The City Plan Commission of the City of Providence shall indicate its approval of the within abandonment by letter to the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Providence. (2) Petitioner shall tender the amount of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) in legal tender U.S. to the City of Providence over a four (4) year period. (3) The petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Providence Water Supply Board and the Department of Communications for the City of Providence, which will permit retention of their facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation. (4) The petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Narragansett Electric Company which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be

determined by the petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation. (5) The petitioner shall, to the approval of the Director of the Department of Public Works, reconstruct the street, curb and sidewalk for the affected portions of Pine Street, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded. And it is further

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the relevant portion of the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper, published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.
