AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POSTING OF ADVERTISING SIGNS ON ANY RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC TRANSIT AUTHORITY BUS SHELTERS WITHIN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

Effective: ~~Approved~~ January 5, 1978

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. ³³Sec. 3-4 entitled, "Posting, Affixing
¹⁶Bills, Posters, Signs, ³Notices to Structures, is hereby amended
as follows;

No person shall ¹³post or otherwise ¹⁰affix, nor cause
to be posted or affixed, any bill, poster, or notice upon any
tree, fence, board, post, pole or Rhode Island Public Transit
Authority Bus Shelters or other structure within or upon the
occupation line of any street or highway and no person shall paint,
print, mark, or cause to be painted, printed or marked, any sign,
notice or advertisement upon any tree, fence, board, post, pole or
Rhode Island Public Transit Authority Bus Shelter or other
structure within or upon the occupation line of any street or
highway, except with the approval, in writing, of the Committee
on Public Works of the City Council and subject to conditions as
said Committee may impose respecting the same.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon
its passage.
