Meeting Street Westerly between Thayer Street and Brown Street.


Olive Street Easterly between Brown Street and Thayer Street

As a result of the traffic study recently completed by the departments of Planning & Development and Traffic Engineering, I hereby recommend that the following streets be made one-way as noted:

Meeting Street shall be one-way westerly between Hope Street and Brook Street
Meeting Street shall be one-way westerly between Thayer Street and Brown Street
Olive Street shall be one-way easterly between Brown Street and Thayer Street
Euclid Street shall be one-way westerly between Thayer Street and Brook Street

These proposed changes are a result of the Thayer Street Traffic Study conducted by the above departments. Both departments recommend the changes which have also been approved by the Thayer Street Merchants Association as well Mary Wheeler School. As a result of these changes approximately forty-six new on-street parking spaces will be allowed.


