Dear Ms. Testa and Mr. Jay Rodriguez,

We need your help! In 1978 we petitioned your department to install "No Parking, 8am to 10am" signs on Academy Avenue between Eaton and Salter Streets. The reason for this action was because students from La Salle Academy, having no place to park on school property, were parking all along Academy Avenue from before 8:00am until their school day ended at 2:30pm and sometimes even later.

It was a huge inconvenience to all of us, not being able to park in front of our own homes. The signs were installed and we were grateful. Several years ago, La Salle Academy provided parking for its students, thus eliminating the need for the "No Parking" signs on our section of Academy Avenue. Because the signs are still in place, we, the residents of Academy Avenue are still subject to morning parking tickets by the Providence Police.

In addition, we have a neighbor who actually calls the police department to inform them of residents who park "illegally". The combination of these signs and this self-appointed "watchdog" has created a whole new inconvenience.

In conclusion, we respectfully ask for your help in removing these signs.
