RELATING TO TAXATION -- PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION

Introduced By: Representatives Moura, DeSimone, and Fox

Date Introduced: April 10, 2003

Referred To: House Corporations

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 44-3-2.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 44-3 entitled "Property
2 Subject to Taxation" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 **44-3-2.2. Tax on certain vehicles and trailers prohibited.** -- Notwithstanding any other
4 provisions of the general laws to the contrary, no city or town shall assess any tax under chapter 5
5 of title 44 on any vehicle or trailer which is registered under chapter 3 of title 31 and taxed under
6 chapter 34 of title 44; provided that the vehicle's owner provides the city or town with
7 documentation proving tax exemption for sales and use tax under section 44-18-40. Any vehicle
8 or trailer which is not registered under chapter 3 of title 31 shall be assessed by a city or town in
9 the same manner as other tangible personal property.
10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would require owners of vehicles to provide a city or town with documentation

PROVIDENCE LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE

SUMMARY SHEET

An Act Relating To: Taxation - Property Subject to Taxation

Amends: R.I.G.L. § 44-3-2.2

Summary: This act would mandate that owners of truck trailers utilized in interstate commerce provide proof of tax exemption to the local tax assessor. A certificate issued by the state division of taxation under R.I.G.L. § 44-18-40 relative to exemption from sales and use tax would be sufficient proof to the local tax assessor to verify the existence of tax exemption for trailers and to properly assess those which do not qualify.



4 city of Providence in an amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) annually for the
5 costs of repairs and capital improvements to the Fox Point Hurricane Barrier in the city of
6 Providence.


