Weeden Street, (portion of) shown as cross-hatched area on accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further







Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its October 5, 1983 regular monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the subject referral. The petition was submitted by Fred Dwyer, who resides at 47 Kenyon Street, Providence, R. I., and who owns two (2) abutting lots Nos. 399 and 391 on AP 28.

The Commission's comments and recommendations are as follows:

A field inspection revealed that the subject portion of Weeden Street at a length of fifty-two (52) feet from its present terminus is paved and used solely by the owner of two abutting lots.


Abutting lot 391 is mostly vacant, used partially for off-street parking; abutting lot 299 contains a two-car garage with a workshop (converted from a former bakery facility).

The subject portion of Weeden Street has no value as a public thoroughfare.

Voted: To advise the Committee on Public Works that no objection is offered on this position.





