



Gentlemen:

At the request of Council Resolution No. 192, dated March 6, 1953, the Traffic Engineer has investigated the advisability of installing a traffic signal at the intersection of Dexter Street and Huntington Avenue.

From traffic volume counts made by one of our field investigators on March 27, 1953, it was found that the traffic volumes on Dexter Street are not high enough to consider the installation of a traffic signal at this intersection at the present. However, the volumes are sufficiently high enough to justify the installation of a STOP SIGN and this will be done in the very near future.

Attached herewith is a traffic regulation that establishes Dexter Street as a STOP street at Huntington Avenue.
