

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 368

Approved May 12, 2003

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is authorized to grant a non-exclusive easement on the sidewalk area on Hope Street at Rochambeau Avenue Street in the City of Providence to Richard Wilson, d/b/a Catering Collaborative, Inc. (729 Hope). Said easement shall be granted specifically upon the following provisions:

1. Said easement shall be utilized only for the installation and maintenance of semi-permanent sidewalk seating for ten persons, immediately adjacent to 729 Hope.. Said easement shall not exceed the area of one-hundred eighty square feet, plus or minus, with dimensions of forty and one-half feet by four feet and indicated on the accompanying map marked as Exhibit A. The sidewalk seating shall be utilized only during the spring and summer seasons.

2. Said easement shall be deemed to run with the land and shall operate against any successors in title and the easement or a memorandum of same shall be recorded in the Office of Land Records for the City of Providence.

3. Said easement shall be subject to a right of reverter/right of reversion in the event that the situs of the easement is no longer utilized for the aforestated purposes.

4. 729 Hope shall execute an indemnification and hold-harmless agreement with the City of Providence. Said agreement shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

5. 729 Hope shall supply the City of Providence with an insurance policy naming said City of Providence, its agents, officers, servants and employees as additional-named insureds in a sum not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) which policy shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

6. In the event that the City of Providence or its designee shall, for any public purpose, require the extinguishment of the easement granted herein and upon the ninety (90) days notice hereinbefore mentioned, 729 Hope shall, at its own expense, and without claim against the City, its officers, servants or employees, for any damages whatsoever, remove said improvements to the easement area.


