WHEREAS, Patrolman Daniel Fanning spotted the alleged perpetrators several blocks away and followed their car and arrested three suspects,




WHEREAS, rarely do regular patrol officers have an opportunity to successfully apprehend and charge individuals involved in major drug distribution operations, and




