



**SUBJECT:** Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Elmhurst Avenue to be established as "One-Way" Street from Eaton Street to Fair Oaks Avenue during school hours, with only school buses being allowed to enter from Fair Oaks Avenue to Eaton Street.

This issue was presented to the DPW - Traffic Engineering following the removal of the "No Parking 8AM to 6PM" signs at the request of Father Ken Letoile. Any traffic congestion that is currently being experienced is a direct result of removing that restriction.

This request is under further study for the AM arrival times. This investigation will help us to determine if the "No Parking 8AM to 6PM" signs should be reinstated.

There were no problems observed during three (3) field checks during the afternoon dismissal.
