No. 203 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1984-53 APPROVED JULY 20, 1984, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) FROM PUBLIC WORKS STREET CLEANING DIVISION (1-005-04-189) TO RECREATION DEPARTMENT, CAMP CRONIN DIVISION (1-006-04-199).

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1984-53 of the Ordinances of the City of providence, as approved July 20, 1984, entitled: "An Ordinance making an Appropriation on One Hundred Seventy-One Million, Fifty Six Thousand, One Hundred Seventy Seven Dollars and Fifty Seven Cents. (\$171,056,177.57) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, as amended", is hereby further amended by transferring the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) from Public Works Street Cleaning Division (1-005-04-189) to Recreation Department, Camp Cronin Division (1-006-04-199).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

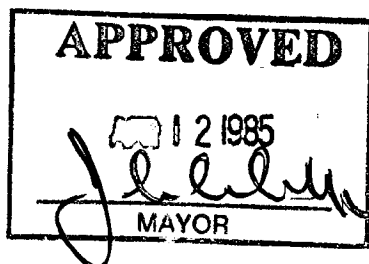


Dear Councilwoman Brassil:

Dear Mr. Baron:

I write to request your support in seeking funding to address the physical conditions at Camp Cronin. As you are aware, Camp Cronin is our City owned and maintained Senior Citizens Program in Narragansett. Unless the conditions of this facility are addressed immediately, the availability of the only program the City maintains for Seniors may be eliminated.

Negotiations are currently underway to sell a large portion of this property to the State of Rhode Island. The remaining area will be utilized for the continuation of the Senior Program and an extension into other educational areas.

After conferring with Mr. Raymond Brown, Director of Recreation, it is felt that we must find the necessary funding for the restoration of this property. The sum of \$15,000 would be sufficient to begin this process.

The Recreation Department is actively pursuing other areas of funding, but it is felt that this sum should be secured for the current year as well as a necessary item in future budget considerations.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter, and if there is any further need for discussion, please contact myself or Mr. Brown in this regard.
