# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 395

Approved June 30, 1982

WHEREAS, Electricity is a vital necessity for all Providence residents, and

WHEREAS, Lower income customers regularly use less electricity than those more well-off, and

WHEREAS, Energy conservation is a proven method of cutting costs for electricity by reducing both the need for the highest priced generation of power and the need to build expensive new power plants, and

WHEREAS, Conservation rates would alter only the rate structure, so Narragansett Electric Company's total revenues would be unchanged,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council request Narragansett Electric Company to alter its rate schedule for residential customers by implementing "Conservation Rates" which would encourage all residents to reduce use of electricity by offering lower prices for lower consumption. This change should be implemented by September 1 to allow residents to cut winter costs.
