SECTION 1. Chapter 1990-14 of the Ordinances of the

in Certain Classes in the City Departments and Repealing
Ordinance Chapter 1989-14, approved June 22, 1989" relative
to Spec. Asst. - Env. Control - Pub. Works, is hereby
amended by deleting and inserting the following in Section
32:

DELETE: 1 Spec. Asst. - Env. Control -
Pub. Works

ADD: 1 Rodent Vermin Control Officer
