Creating a Class ^R~~B~~ Legitimate Theater Beverage License

Introduced By: *Sen. Hyland*
Date Introduced: *3/14*
Referred To: *Special Legislation*

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 Section 1: Chapter 3-7 of the General Laws,
2 1956, as amended, entitled "Retail licenses", is
3 hereby further amended by adding thereto the follow-
4 ing section:
5 "3-7-16.1. Class ~~R~~^R Legitimate Theater
6 License--Legitimate theaters, as hereinafter
7 defined, may apply for a Class ~~B~~^B license. Such
8 a license shall authorize the holder thereof to keep
9 for sale and to sell beverages at retail in the place
10 therein described and to deliver the same for con-
11 sumption on the premises where sold at the times
12 when scheduled live theatrical productions may be
13 held on the said premises, and for a period of one
14 (1) hour prior to such productions and one (1) hour
15 subsequent thereto, provided such productions begin
16 subsequent to 1:30 p.m. The licenses premises may

1 contain a bar. Such Class J 1 license shall authorize
2 entertainment only in conformity with ordinances of
3 the city or town wherein such facility is located on
4 the licensed premises. Class ~~J 1~~ licenses shall only
5 be issued by the local licensing authority. The annual
6 fee for such a license shall be one half (1/2) that of
7 a class B license in such city or town and shall be
8 payable to the town or city where the licenses premises
9 are located.

10 "Legitimate theatre", for the purposes of this
11 section, shall include those organizations presenting
12 live, scheduled theatrical productions on a regular
13 basis throughout the year.

14 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
