Chapter 21 Revenue & Finance by adding Article 21-190 entitled "Tax
Exemption for certain property owned by the Providence Redevelopment
Agency".

Approved October 13, 2000

Be it ordained by the City of Providence: That the code of
Ordinances, Chapter 21 Revenue & Finance be amended by adding the
following:

"ARTICLE XI"

Section 21-190 Tax Exemption for certain property owned by the
Providence Redevelopment Agency.

1. Certain real property acquired and owned by the Providence
Redevelopment Agency which has been acquired for development
of the new Public Safety facility shall be "exempt from taxation,"
pursuant to R.I. General Law Sec. 1-45-32-40 of the General
Law's in Chapter 45-32 entitled "Redevelopment Projects," as
amended.
2. Certain properties identified as : Plat 25 Lots 380, 387, 53, 54, 55,
56, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 75, 76, 218, 79, 222, 227, 224, 223;
Plat 29 Lots 113, 112, 444, 115 also included are the following:

FHE Parcel #8 Portion of Interstate 95 Service Road #7

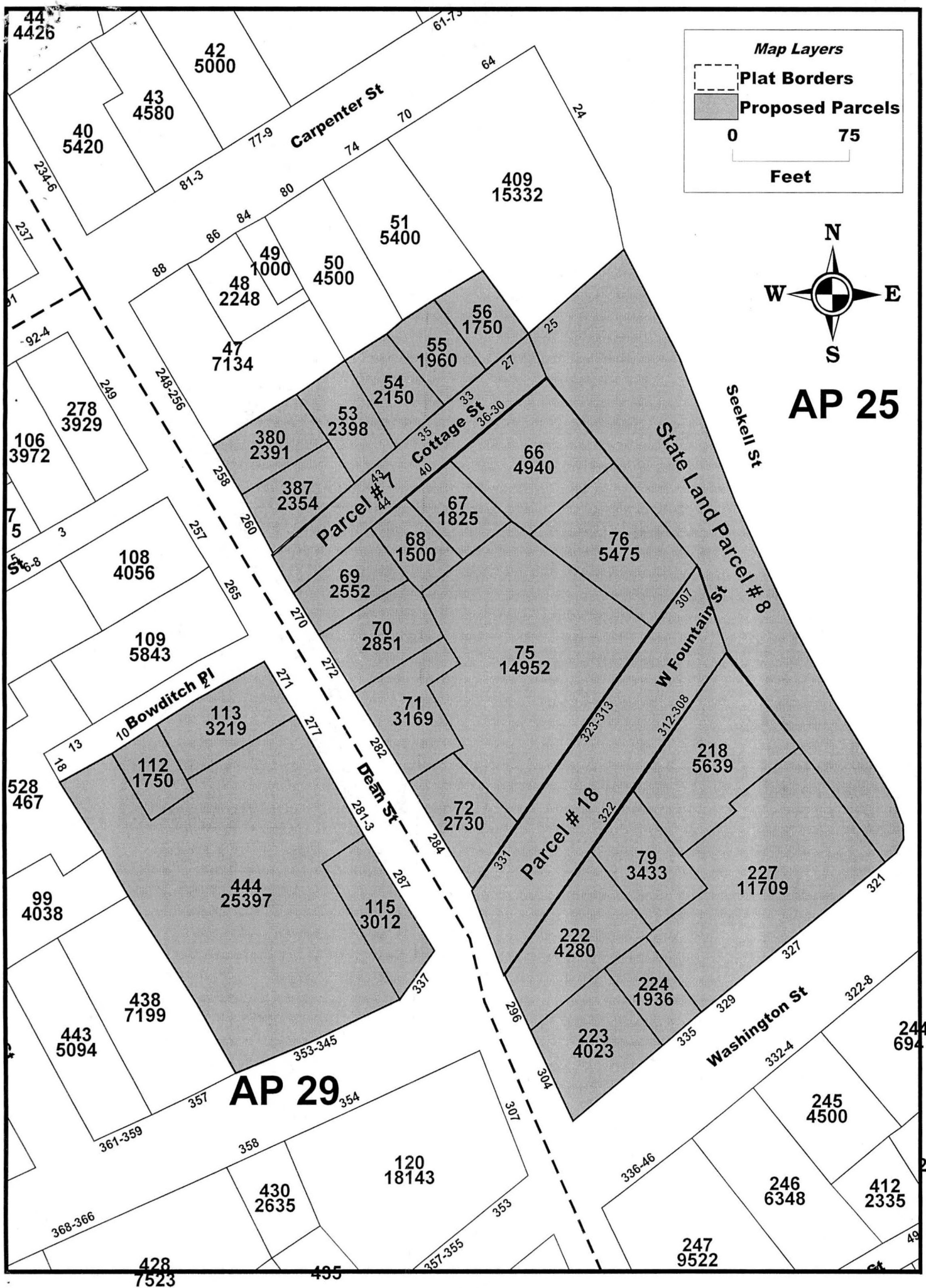
