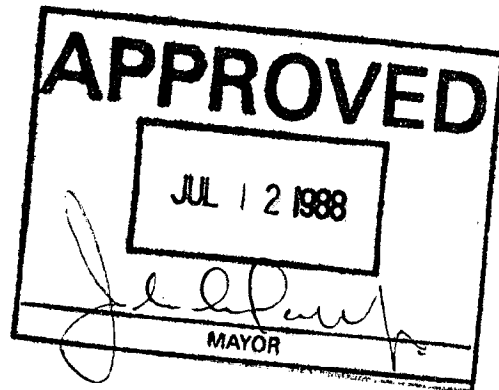



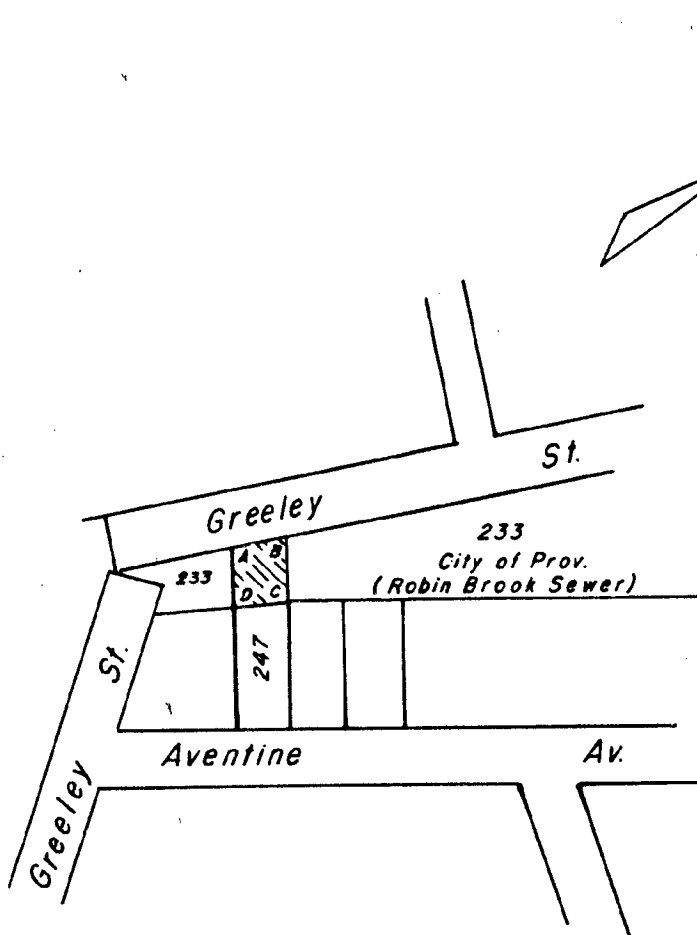

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its June 14, 1988 regular monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the proposed right-of-way easement on a portion of city owned property described as Assessor's Plat 98, Lot 233 and abutting the property on 14 Aventine Avenue described as Assessor's Plat 98, Lot 247.

The petitioner is Mr. Steward Evens, Jr., owner of abutting property on 14 Aventine Avenue, who wants to legalize the existing physical access to his garages from Greeley Street.

A field inspection revealed that Lot 233 on A.P. 98 is vacant land overgrown with weeds and brush. This land was reserved many years ago for the so-called "Robin Brook Sewer Easement" and cannot be developed for any use requiring construction on the site. It could however, be utilized as a garden, parking lot, open space etc., with the stipulation that any plans for such use should be approved by the Department of Public Works - Engineering Division.


The petitioner maintains, at present, a dirt and gravel road access to his garages from Greeley Street.


