

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 156

Approved February 24, 1995

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of Providence, the Providence School Committee and the Superintendent of Providence Schools have joined in support of the Pawtucket, Woonsocket and West Warwick Law Suit now before the Supreme Court having been appealed by the State of Rhode Island, and

WHEREAS, This suit would affect the City of Providence in terms of State Funding for Education, and

WHEREAS, Other community Agencies and advocates for the improvement of Education in Providence have joined as "Friends of the Court" i.e., AMICUS CURIAE, and
