



Gentlemen:

Having recently appeared before the committee on business involving the City of Providence contracting a sewer main in Perry St. on the evening of July 20, 1982 I must write to say first I apologize for any unusual circumstances which may have developed, namely, a very unruly and inconsiderate few people who seemed to have conspired against my request to get help solving my problem, an antiquated cesspool which over the years is no longer able to function properly and my problem of handling this waste water.

I did not attempt to have the City of Providence give me anything for nothing or at any taxpayers expense as one person remarked, but the person has overlooked the fact that I too am a taxpayer merely trying to get a service they enjoy but will deny me and my family the same for what appears their greed and selfishness.

② I did not intend to cause any hardships for anyone if what they say, "the expense to them is not necessary, and they don't need it" the sewer line, again they are not considering the true matter and meaning of my request, only that they have the service thanks to the efforts of perhaps their grandfather doing then what I am trying to do now.

I had made attempts with the same people to share a private sewer line at #23 Derry St. at a cost to me and any maintenance fees but the owners were unwilling then as I imagine now to this proposal, which considering their actions I would not pursue any further, especially at this point.

Having written this letter I feel that I have said some things which should be said and the committee should know, but - perhaps I too must take a selfish attitude toward this matter as others have shown because I desperately need the service for obvious reasons, especially health.

I will close by saying this problem would not be if the City had given thought to this lack of service on Derry St., rather than a remark by a City Engineer, "this is a street time has forgotten"; i am only asking for a service that perhaps people take for granted, as a citizen and property owner, and appreciate any help i can get.

Dear Council Members:


As a property owner at Geoffrey Ct., I wish to protest Ronald Mello's petition for a main drain.
