No. **AN ORDINANCE** CREATING THE DEPARTMENT OF
MARITIME SERVICES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND
REPEALING SECTIONS 11-18 AND 11-19 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

Approved

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Establishment. There is hereby created a department of maritime services of the City of Providence.

SECTION 2. Director of the Department of Maritime Services; Appointment--Term. The head of the department of maritime services of the City of Providence shall be known and designated as the director of the department of maritime services. The director shall be appointed by the Mayor, as soon as feasible upon enactment of this legislation, to serve until the first day of January, 1981. The director shall then be appointed by the Mayor for a term of two (2) years beginning on the first day of January, 1981, and biannually thereafter.

SECTION 3. Deputies, Clerks, Assistants; Appointment. Subject to such civil service provisions as may be enacted by ordinance, the director of the department of maritime services shall have the appointment and removal of all deputies, clerks, assistants, and other subordinates serving under his direction as may from time to time be authorized.

SECTION 4. Powers and Duties of the Director. The director of the department of maritime services of the City of Providence shall have full and complete charge, direction, supervision, management care and control of the municipal wharf and the marine terminal. Also, the director shall control and direct the trade, business, activities and development of the harbor and port of Providence in a manner not inconsistent with Chapter 11 entitled, "Harbor and Port" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence.

SECTION 5. Director to Solicit Business for Port. In addition to his other duties it shall be the duty of the director of the department of maritime services to seek out, solicit, and interest ship officials, manufacturers, shippers and others, who have occasion to use transportation, in the facilities and advantages of the port of Providence.

SECTION 6. Repeal of Sections 11-18 and 11-19. Sections 11-18 and 11-19 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence are hereby repealed, in any case where the provisions of this article or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto is found to be in conflict with the provisions of any other ordinance, resolution, rules or regulations of the City of Providence, the provisions of this article shall apply.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
