

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 132

Approved March 14, 1974

WHEREAS, Repeated reports that inhumane treatment has been inflicted upon American prisoners of war, as well as their allies, and interference with attempts to locate American POW's, and

WHEREAS, the following from Rhode Island are still missing:

Air Force Col. Curtis Eaton
of Narragansett, missing since 1966

Army Capt. Kenneth Goff, Jr.
of Warwick, missing since 1967

Air Force Capt. Fredrick Mellor
of Cranston, missing since 1966

Navy Lt. O. J. Pender, Jr.
of Warwick, missing since 1972

Army Staff Sgt. Louis Clark Walton
of Cranston, missing since 1971, and

Air Force Master Sgt. Samuel Adams
of North Kingstown, missing since 1965, and

WHEREAS, Visits and inspections by the Americans have been denied and interfered with to these same prisoners of war and repeated demands upon the North Vietnamese and Communist Government for such have been ignored.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That immediate steps be taken for the mechanics of locating missing American soldiers, and that inspections be effected, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this Resolution be sent to the officials of North Vietnam, the Secretary of State, the National League of Families of American Prisoners and Missing in Action in Southeast Asia, and other appropriate United States officials.
