Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

With regards to City Council Resolution No. 791, dated September 14, 1979, resolving that the Department of Building Inspection cause the vacant structure at 89-91 Adelaide Avenue to be razed, please be advised that this Department issued a notice on September 6, 1979, to the owner, Elizabeth Bogosian, c/o Woloohojian Realty Corp., notifying her that the building had been ordered demolished.

Subsequent to receiving notification, Mrs. Bogosian contacted this office and informed us that it was her intent to rehabilitate the structure in addition to other structures on Adelaide Avenue, using federal funds from the Section 8 Housing Program.

She also informed me that she would take legal action to appeal my order to demolish the building if it were necessary.

Because of the extremely drawn out procedure involving legal actions to demolish vacant buildings, I propose that she board and secure the building, shore up the porch which is in danger of collapsing, and clean the yard of debris, pending the rehabilitation of this building.

At the present time the building has been shored and has been secured, but no attempt has been made to clean the debris. I will be monitoring the progress of the owner to keep the building secure and to clean the yard until October 30, 1979, at which time the feasibility of the Section 8 Project will be determined. If the project at that time is not feasible, I will proceed with demolition of the property.
