AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1563, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 6, 1963, BEING "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PEDESTRIAN MALL ON A PORTION OF WESTMINSTER STREET AND CERTAIN INTERSECTING STREETS."

Approved

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Section III, paragraph "k" is amended to read as follows:

"All vehicular traffic prohibited on Aborn Street from Washington Street to Fountain Street.

"One way in a southeasterly direction from Washington Street to Westminster Street."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all Ordinances and existing traffic regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
