


WHEREAS, it is becoming increasingly difficult for residents of the City of Providence to procure off-street parking facilities for motor vehicles due to the increased number of motor vehicles owned by residents of the City of Providence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Committee on Public Works is requested to undertake a study as to the feasibility of authorizing all night parking of motor vehicles on City of Providence Streets by its residents, with the exception of nights when street cleaning and snow removal is to be effected, upon such nights alternate all night parking shall be authorized.
