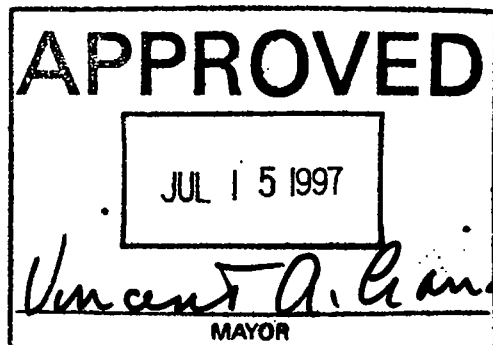
WHEREAS, The work accomplished by the Providence Housing Authority affects the quality of life in the entire City of Providence,

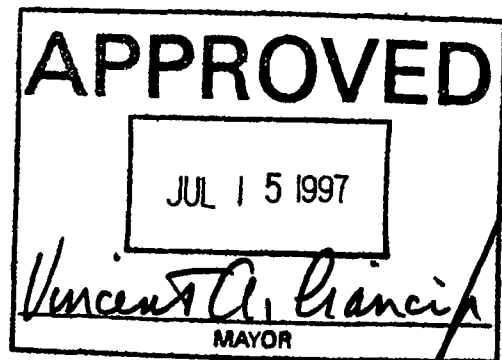
