RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 202

Approved April 10, 1974

WHEREAS, that particular bridge along Branch Avenue, over and across the Penn-Central Railroad Tracks, appears to be in a structually dangerous state of disrepair, and

WHEREAS, the bridge deck is also in a dangerous state of disrepair, and

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been brought to the attention of Council President Pro-Tempore Salvatore A. Beatini, concerning these same conditions,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Referee in Bankruptcy of the Penn-Central Railroad Company is hereby urgently requested to authorize the immediate repair of the bridge structure and the bridge deck, so that what may be serious consequences will be averted.
