Dear Mr. Hassett:

In accordance with our conversation of Thursday, April 24th, I am requesting the Providence Recreation Department to make the following repairs on our tennis courts. I understand it will be subject to the availability of funds.

Both our courts need re-surfacing, preferably black top.

Both will need new lines painted.

One court will need a new steel net and posts.

Both courts should be fenced in in their entirety by a 10 ft. cyclone fence. There is at present a partial fencing around both courts by this type of fence, and I feel it should surround the entire court for the best protection. Each of the present existing fences contains a gate which could and should be made secure by locking.

I hope you will be able to assist us in this for we have a strong tennis program. Thank you for your interest and attention.
