
It is respectfully recommended that a Crossing Guard Post be established at the corner of Eastwood and Laurel Hill Avenues.

A survey conducted by our Traffic Division showed that on May 20, 1975, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. - 8:45 A.M., 23 children crossed at this location, and there were already some children in the school yard.

Between the hours of 11:15 A.M. - 11:45 A.M., 26 children crossed at Laurel Hill Avenue and 70 children crossed at Eastwood Avenue; also, a number of children crossed in the middle of the block.

As the report indicates, there is a definite need for a Crossing Guard to be posted at this corner and temporarily there is one assigned there.
