RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 268

Approved May 28, 1973

WHEREAS, the General Assembly, in its wisdom, has allocated the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars for the repair of certain bridges over and across the Penn-Central Railroad tracks along Branch, Smithfield, and Atwells Avenues, and

WHEREAS, His Excellency the Governor has approved that allocation of funds to be expended under the direction of the State Director of Transportation so that the state of disrepair which exists upon the same bridge decks may be repaired and eliminate the chagrin and possible damage to motor vehicles as has occurred in the past,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in recognition of the allocation of the sum of \$10,000 for the aforesaid repairs, His Honor, Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the City Council, particularly those members that represent the several wards in which the bridges are located, express their appreciation to His Excellency the Governor, the Members of the General Assembly, the State Director of Transportation, and the staff of Public Works Engineers who, having recognized this problem, collectively move for its elimination.
