No. 544 AN ORDINANCE

Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1996-44, Approved November 15, 1996.

Approved September 29, 1997

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The number of employees in the Providence Water Supply Board shall not exceed two hundred sixty six (261) at any one time. Within each of the following classifications, there shall be no more than:
