Dept. Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 063839, Date August 16, 1974. Said conveyance having been requested by the Chief of the Providence Fire Department for the construction and use as the Fire Department Training Site, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said conveyance shall be subject to any easement to the Department of Public Works, as it shall deem necessary, to its existing twelve inch force main serving the Washington Park Pump Station.



Subject: City Owned Land for Fire Department Training Site  
Sir:

It is respectfully requested that the City Property Committee designate the westerly portion of Plat 56, Lot 256 consisting of approximately five (5) acres  $\pm$  for construction and use as the Fire Department Training Academy. This area is located to the sides and rear of the City of Providence Dog Pound.

Development of this particular portion of land area will provide an adequate Fire Department Training site for the city.

Construction of a new training site will release 25,020 sq. ft. of land and a building presently in use as a training station at Reservoir and Roger Williams Avenue, (Plat 61, Lot 605).

The Department of Public Works has reviewed the site delineated on the enclosed plan, and has informed me that the site has been lying dormant for years as a possible extension of the Sewage Treatment Plant.

I have been made aware of the existing twelve-inch force main servicing the Washington Park Pumping Station; I am also aware that the City of Providence has engaged Waterman Engineering for a complete study of the sewage plant including the distribution system. In view of all of this information, I feel that a list of priorities dictate that this site be established for the proposed Fire Department Training Site.

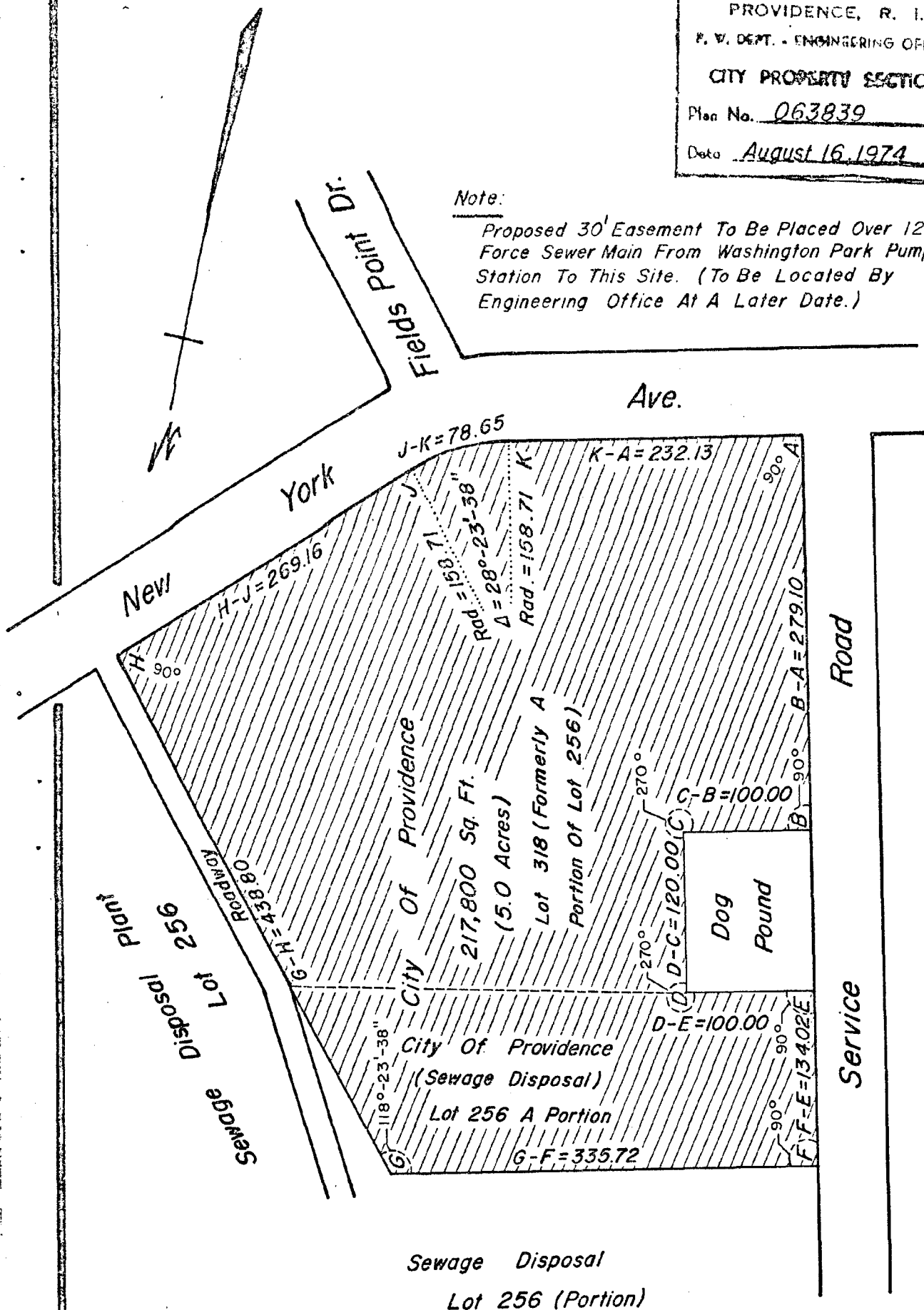
