It is our pleasure to send you the Annual Report of Roger Williams Medical Center for the fiscal year ended Sept. 30, 1998. You will note in the financial summary that our operating bottom line was virtually break-even -- a successful result for any hospital in today's environment. This was a significant accomplishment in a year when reimbursements from government and commercial payors continued to be reduced. It was a challenge to maintain both quality and financial equilibrium under these circumstances, and we are proud that our results compare very favorably with those of other area hospitals.

Despite the financial pressures, the first priority at Roger Williams remains the provision of the highest quality medical care. As shown through the words of our patients and the pictures of our advanced capabilities, the enclosed report brings to life the philosophy of our institution:

We don't just treat problems -- we treat people.


Just a few days after the report rolled off the printing press, we were notified that Roger Williams had achieved a significant honor: we were named one of the 100 Top Hospitals in the country by the respected consulting firms HCIA and William M. Mercer, Inc. The annual HCIA/Mercer list is based on statistical analysis of objective data collected from hospitals all over the country. It identifies those hospitals that have achieved high performance on key measures related to clinical practice, operations and financial management. Roger Williams is the only hospital in Rhode Island to appear on the 1998 list.



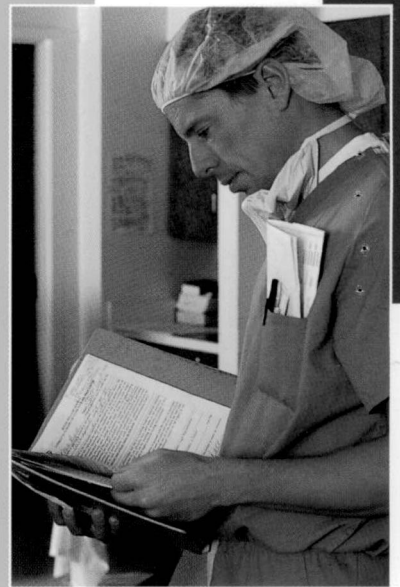
on track with **ambulatory surgery** express

◀ Patients scheduled for same-day surgery want to get in, get out and start getting better. So RWMC has begun a new program designed to make operations as easy and stress-free as possible.

Called **Ambulatory Surgery Express**, the new program cuts down on waiting (and the worry that goes with it) by assuring that procedures start on time. The program also helps patients stay on track by keeping laboratory tests to a minimum, bringing caregivers to the patient's bedside – rather than moving the patient around – and encouraging patients to see themselves as healthy

people who are partners in their own care. Many are permitted to wear their own clothes instead of a hospital "johnny" and many are encouraged to walk out of the unit instead of riding in a wheelchair.

"The program is about efficiency – and about respecting patients' feelings," says Kathleen Hittner, MD, chair of the department of anesthesia and administrative medical director of the operating room. "Our goal is to be the benchmark against which other hospital operating rooms measure themselves."

► **A Learning Organization**

Roger Williams Medical Center is a learning organization committed to advancing the skills and knowledge of everyone who works here. In 1998 we provided:

- A wide range of programs on such key issues as critical care, cancer care and care tailored for the special needs of older patients.
- Intensive training in emergency care through the RWMC-based Emergency Medical Services Training Academy (recently named a Community Training Center by the American Heart Association).
- On site, one-on-one training in new procedures, equipment and techniques.
- Access to Health & Science Television Network and Joint Satellite Network presentations on advances in care and technology.
- A new Clinical Resources Center that makes it easy for caregivers to find the information they need.

► Despite the continued pressures on all healthcare institutions, 1998 has been a **remarkably successful** one for Roger Williams Medical Center. Our admissions are up. Our medical staff continues to grow. And we are engaged in nearly \$9 million of important and productive research.

In addition, we've celebrated a milestone and earned some very high marks. The milestone came in January, when our Home Care department celebrated 10 years of service to the community. The high marks included:

- a top rating for our mammography services from the Department of Health and Human Services;
- reaccreditation – for the longest period allowed – for our residency and fellowship programs; and
- accreditation for both long term and subacute care for Elmhurst Extended Care, our highly respected nursing home. Only 2% of nursing facilities nationwide achieve this kind of dual accreditation.

The high marks also included a decision on the part of the RI Department of Health to give our Subacute Care Unit a deficiency-free rating. According to the Department, that perfect score is “a rare accomplishment... in this state and perhaps the country.”

► A commitment to excellence

This past year RWMC gained strength from some truly exceptional individuals.

One of our community's most respected leaders, Herbert W. Cummings, became the chairman of our Board of Trustees. Mr. Cummings, who has been a member of our Board since 1992, is the former vice-chairman of Citizens Financial Group, Inc. and its subsidiary, Citizens Bank of Rhode Island. He currently serves as chairman of the Rhode Island Airport Corporation and is active in a number of other community service organizations.

Our board was also strengthened by the addition of Aram V. Chobanian, MD, Dean and Provost of the Boston University School of Medicine. A native Rhode Islander – and member of the RI Hall of Fame –

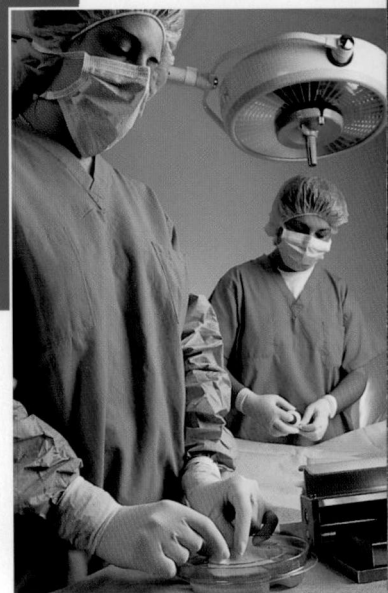
Then, in July of this year, Roger Williams became the first hospital in the state to offer these

people a chance to heal – through the use of a totally new product that looks, feels and **acts like living skin**.

Called Apligraf, the new product is grown in the laboratory using human skin cells. It is applied to a chronic wound in a simple, painless, procedure and immediately begins to protect the wound and help it heal.

According to Vincent J. Falanga, MD, FACP, chairman of the RWMC department of dermatology and skin surgery and the researcher who led the national testing of Apligraf, the new treatment heals more leg ulcers – even the most difficult ones – faster.

"Quite simply" he says, "it is going to revolutionize the care of wounds."

Dr. Chobanian is a professor of both medicine and pharmacology and the John I. Sandson Distinguished Professor of Health Sciences at BUSM. He also serves on both the board of trustees and the executive committee of Boston Medical Center.

In addition to the many fine doctors who have joined our staff this year, RWMC welcomed two exceptional physicians, Gerald J. Elfenbein, MD, FACP; and Vincent Falanga, MD, FACP to leadership positions at our institution.

Dr. Elfenbein, who now heads our Cancer Center and Blood & Marrow Transplant Program, is an internationally recognized cellular immunologist in the field of bone marrow transplantation. A graduate of Harvard and The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, Dr. Elfenbein served most recently as Professor of Internal Medicine and Interim Director of Clinical Research at the University of South Florida College of Medicine.

Dr. Falanga, who heads our department of dermatology, is an internationally known expert on wounds and wound healing. He received his MD degree from Harvard Medical School. An active researcher, Dr. Falanga serves as a consultant for the National Institutes of Health and the Food and Drug Administration. He is a professor of dermatology at BUSM.

getting patients back on

► Visit most hospitals and you'll find some patients who aren't sick at all. They're basically healthy people who have had broken bones, joint replacement, back surgery

or other orthopedic procedures. They don't need the same kinds of care other patients require. What they do need is help getting up, gaining strength and getting ready to go home.

Roger Williams recently became the only hospital in the state to offer these people a unit dedicated entirely to getting them back on their feet. Called the **Orthopedic Center**, it brings together all the resources they need in one cheerful and caring setting.

The unit offers private and semiprivate rooms, its own staff of specially trained orthopedic nurses and physical therapy

seven days a week – including a physical therapy gym located inside the Center.

"The focus is on recovery," says Louis J. Mariorenzi, MD, director of the RWMC division of orthopedics. "Everyone – the doctors, nurses, physical therapists and support staff – can concentrate on helping patients get better as quickly as possible."



► Breaking new ground

RWMC continued its tradition of innovation by adding new programs to meet the health care needs of our community. You'll find some of these programs profiled in this report. We also established a Sleep Disorders Center, added new diagnostic capabilities for our neurology, cardiology and radiology departments and welcomed a new ophthalmology practice to our Elmhurst Campus.

In addition, we celebrated the opening of a very special place, the Horticultural Therapy Gardens of Elmhurst. These gardens, funded through the generosity of our community, will bring the beauty of plants and flowers – and the pleasure of gardening – to residents of Elmhurst Extended Care and the Philip Hulitar Hospice facility for years to come.

▲ Imagine a cancer treatment so carefully targeted that it can destroy tumor cells without damaging the healthy tissue nearby. That's the idea behind **radioactive seed implantation**, a process being used at a number of major medical centers, including Roger Williams, to treat early-stage prostate cancer.

In radioactive seed implantation, tiny pellets of radioactive material are placed inside the prostate by a multi-disciplinary team that includes urologists, radiation oncologists and a physicist. The process, which does not require open surgery, results in a reduced risk of side effects like incontinence and impotence, causes less discomfort than surgery and

lets patients recover more quickly.

For several years, RWMC has been the only hospital in the state to offer this advanced procedure. Now, we've added new, extremely sophisticated imaging technology and expanded the program.

► Meeting the need

When several meningitis cases struck the state, RWMC employees struck back, providing vaccinations for over 500 young people at a March meningitis immunization clinic at the hospital. Staff from RWMC also participated in major immunization efforts at the Silver Lake Community Center, Pilgrim High School in Warwick and several other locations statewide.

RWMC continued its effort to help people detect cancer early through our free breast and prostate cancer screening programs. We have also continued our partnership with CVS and WJAR Channel 10 to promote colorectal cancer screening. This program, which includes information and a free colorectal cancer testing kit, has significantly raised community awareness of colorectal cancer and resulted in tens of thousands of requests for the kit.

In addition, RWMC has offered an exceptional array of health education and screening programs at our ContinuCare offices in area senior centers and throughout the community.

Most important, at a time when many people believe medicine is becoming increasingly impersonal, the skilled and compassionate people of RWMC continue to give our patients the care and attention they deserve. It is what we are here for – and it matters. Just ask Mary A. Smith of Providence, a recent patient who wrote to say:

"To enter a hospital where one finds so many people concerned with patient care, not just clinical but personal, is a very fine experience, indeed, and that is just what mine was."
