No. 1 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 21-13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED: "FILING FEE FOR PETITION TO ABANDON PUBLIC HIGHWAY".

Approved JANUARY 8, 1981

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 21-13, Article I, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled:

"Filing fee for petition to abandon public highway", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No petition for an abandonment of a public highway shall be accepted by the clerk of the city council, unless accompanied by a filing fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) which shall be deposited with the city clerk, and no part of which shall be returnable to the petitioner."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
