WHEREAS, the property of this company make it one of the City's largest taxpayers,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor appoint a Special Committee composed of three members thereof, not more than two of whom shall be from the same political party, to meet with officials of the U. S. Rubber Company in order to determine whether there is anything this city, through the Mayor, the City Council and/or the City's Administrative Officers can do to assist the company in maintaining its present level of employment and production.





To the Honorable the City Council of Providence

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to report to your Honorable Body concerning a resolution requesting an investigation to determine the necessity of increasing the police foot patrol in the Washington Park area.

The staff of the police department has carefully studied and evaluated the situation in Washington Park. The Chief has recommended that no change be made in the patrol coverage of this area. I concur with this recommendation and respectfully inform your Honorable Body to that effect.

The following extract from the Chief's report is presented to provide your Honorable Body with the reasons for his recommendation.

"At the present time, this area is being covered by Car Post 11 which is also responsible for the patrol of Roger Williams Park and the residential area north of the park to Sackett Street from Broad Street to Elmwood Avenue. In all of 1963, the total number of crimes and incidents originating on this post and reported to the police was 1,006. Of this number, 736 were either miscellaneous incidents or medical aided cases of a non-criminal nature.

"Further evaluation of the total 1,006 calls emanating from this post during the past year reveals that Car 11 averaged 2.7 calls per 24 hour day, and but .9 calls for each 8 hour tour of duty, a relatively light case-load which allows ample time for preventive and repressive patrol by uniformed officers assigned to this post.

"Car 12, Car 13, and Cruiser 1 are other mobile units having posts which adjoin the Washington Park area and its environs, and each of these units frequently passes through and/or spends patrol time in this section. Moreover, the Traffic Bureau has two established mobile patrol posts within the Washington Park area which provide further police coverage.

"The commanding officer of the Patrol Bureau reports no unusual or emergency conditions or situations in this area at the present time which would seem to require the posting of extra patrols here. Should such condition or situation arise and be of apparent limited duration, the Mobile Task Force and/or K-9 Corps would be made available for strengthening the existing patrols of the involved area."
