**AN ACT Declaring October 11, as General Casimir  
Pulaski Day.**

**It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:**

Section 1. Chapter 25-2 of the general laws entitled  
“Days of special observance” is hereby amended by  
adding thereto the following section.

“25-2-15. **GENERAL CASIMIR PULASKI DAY.**—

The eleventh day of October shall be set apart as a  
day to be known as General Casimir Pulaski day”.  
Said day to be observed by the people of this state  
with appropriate exercises in public places.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
