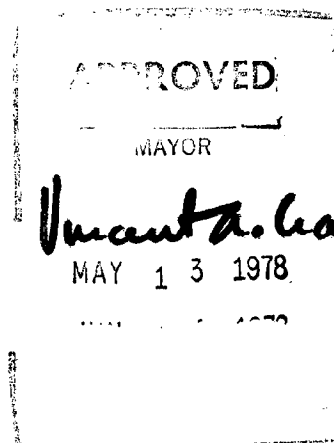
WHEREAS, Service in the Army of the United States of America, preceeded his employment in the data-processing section of the Finance Department of the City of Providence,
